OUR REFERRAL PROCESS

1

Call or contact us with your referral, and we'll collect all of the information we need to start the supported living referral process.

2

We will arrange a one-on-one assessment to spend time with the person and their family to understand their present circumstances, support requirements, and short-, medium-, and long-term goals.

3

We will arrange for the person and their family to see our available supported living housing or residential homes after we have developed our suggestion for support, allowing them the chance to meet our staff and ask questions.

4

We'll create a financing request outlining the support hours needed and submit it for approval, keeping you updated along the way.

5

We'll set a move-in date and start the transition process once the funds have been authorised. We'll be on hand to provide support and advice throughout the process to ensure that everything runs smoothly.
